DECEMBER EMPHASIS NAZARENE COMPASSIONATE MINISTRIES

Following the example of Jesus, NCM partners with local Nazarene congregations around the world to clothe, shelter, feed, heal, educate, and live in solidarity with those who suffer under oppression, injustice, violence, poverty, hunger, and disease. NCM exists in and through the Church to proclaim the Gospel to all people.

NMI has come alongside NCM in leading the Nazarene church in living out compassion.

December is Compassionate Ministries Emphasis month in the Church of the Nazarene. The Board of General Superintendents designated December to encourage a spirit of compassion and personal involvement among Nazarenes everywhere. NCM's prayer is that social holiness would erupt in every local church and that we could come alongside faithful members and resource them to serve.

DID YOU KNOW???

- ~ The Church of the Nazarene ministers in 156 world areas. The newest world area entered is: Africa Region—Mali.
- ~ In 2009, Churches in world mission areas numbered 12,451 churches (an increase of 9%) with 1.28 million members (an increase of 9.8%) in those areas.
- ~ NMI partnered with Nazarene Compassionate Ministries to give more than US \$6.68 million to support 10,958 children through Child Development, an increase of 1,195 children sponsored over the previous year.
- ~ Churches sent 40,308 Crisis Care Kits to Ethiopia, Haiti, Sri Lanka, Zambia, and Ukraine and 14,680 School Pal-Paks (an increase of 4,320) to Ethiopia, Sri Lanka, Ukraine, and Zambia.
