

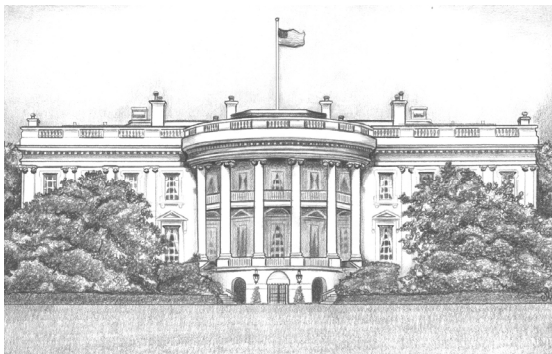

Transportation

We will be taking the Church Bus to Washington, D.C. It will be a two day drive to and from the Community of Hope Nazarene Church. The drive is approximately 17hrs (8.5hrs each day). We will be breaking in Knoxville, TN each way. Travel lodging will be at Knoxville First Church of the Nazarene. We will have at least 2 licensed eligible bus drivers on board for safety and to prevent any unplanned driver circumstances.

Lodging

Once arriving in D.C. we will be staying at one of several options depending on the number of students and adults coming on the trip. We have arrangements that can be finalized with the Community of Hope Church, at an Extended Stay Hotel and with a camp ground in the D.C. area.

Trip Parent Meeting(s)

We will have several Trip Meetings to discuss the D.C. details. These meetings will be held:

1. Pre-First Payment Sun. February 27, 2011.
2. Parent & Teen Meeting Wed. May 11, 2011.
3. Finalizing Trip Meeting Sun. June 12, 2011

Extra Money

Your student will have the option to bring extra money for dining out and to buy souvenirs. There may also be a site that costs money that they want to visit that isn't included in the \$350 cost. *However* we will do our best to include as much as we can for the \$350 price. Each student will receive \$5 per meal for lunch and dinner while we travel. For the exception of lunch the day we leave (June 18) bring a sack lunch. Any money beyond the \$5 given during lunch will be on your own.
